Do we live in a melting pot or a salad bowl, and what's the difference? Does it matter? This topic's course explores this question as it applies to the French Caribbean and beyond. Reading fiction and non-fiction by authors from Martinique, Guadeloupe, Haiti, and Francophone Louisiana, students examine living in a multicultural society through a Creole lens.

Course taught in English. Students in FREN 430 read and produce work in French (Prerequisite: FREN 339 or permission from instructor)

Students in MLL 450 read translations and produce work in English. Prerequisite: ENG 100
