What's New!!

- All events will be done **remotely**. Training is provided prior to the event which will last between 60 to 120 minutes. More information will be provided by the Head Judge Advisor and Head Referee.
- Judging and robot games will be performed on separate dates.
- Typical judging times of teams are noon 5 pm; Referee time are 8 am 1 pm.
 Volunteers will be contacted to confirm the schedule as soon as possible.

- Judging Event (Core Values, Robot Performance, Project) March 19, 2022
