Joy Bergelson is the James D. Watson Distinguished service professor, and Chair of the Department of Ecology and Evolution at The University of Chicago and a member of the National Academy of Sciences. An early researcher of the plant *Arabidopsis thaliana*, particularly from an evolutionary and ecological perspective, Bergelson and her group completed the first experiments using genetically manipulated plants to disentangle the mechanisms driving observed evolutionary dynamics. They have also pioneered research at the interface of ecology and evolution, namely eco-evolutionary dynamics.
