


Call for Student Posters



The 79thWorld Science Fiction Convention

Share your research with the public and possibly win a prize

The 2021 World Science Fiction Convention (discon3.org) is looking for undergraduate students, graduate students or post-doctoral scholars to participate in a poster competition on Saturday, Dec. 18. The convention will be at the Omni Shoreham Hotel in Washington, DC, on December 15-19, 2021. There will be a \$100 prize for the poster that best communicates science to the general public. There is no fee to enter the competition.

Poster Session

Here is an opportunity to share your research with an audience that is very interested in science, engineering and technology. The posters will be displayed for the entire convention. To participate in the competition, you must be at your poster from 12-2 PM, Saturday, Dec. 18, to answer questions and meet the fans.

Poster Format and Printing

The posters will be printed by the convention. You will need to send us an electronic file suitable to printing no later than Nov. 29. We will send details about poster and file format upon registration for the competition. Since the poster should be aimed at a general audience, **DO NOT** simply recycle a poster from a professional meeting. Be creative!

Entry and Registration

To participate, send an email to Sam Scheiner (posters@discon3.org) **no later than November 19**. Please include your name, your academic affiliation, the poster title, and an abstract of no more than 100 words. Note that the convention has a strict vaccination and masking policy (https://discon3.org/news/covid-policy/).
