The Washington University in St. Louis (WUSTL) ENDURE program prepares undergraduates from diverse backgrounds for neuroscience PhD programs. We combine outstanding research training, a rigorous curriculum and an empowering support system that allows participants to thrive on their path to graduate school and beyond. With support from the NIH BP-ENDURE initiative and Washington University, accepted students are funded for up to two summers. Overall, the program embeds students in a network of neuroscientists and enhances trainee success.
