Founder and CEO SharpRank B.A. Economics, UMBC MBA University of Virginia

After hearing a radio ad for a prognosticator selling his picks/predictions on upcoming NFL games, Chris and his partner noticed a gap in the rapidly developing sports betting market. As a banker, Chris was required to take FINRA exams, pass background checks, get fingerprinted, maintain compliance, etc. In the sports betting market, there was none of this. There was no independent oversight. In the Wild West of Sports Betting, there was no Sheriff. In that moment, SharpRank was founded to act as the industry's independent ratings agency.

Michael is an Al enthusiast, Meyerhof Scholar, and the CEO and Co-Founder of MindStand Technologies.
