Cost for UMBC Students

The Washington Center has partnered with your school and you can expect to pay the following amount:

Fall/Spring

- Cost per credit
- **Program Fee:** \$9,700
- **Housing Fee:** \$6,570

Summer

- Cost per credit
- **Program Fee:** \$7,500
- **Housing Fee:** \$4,990

This cost could be offset by financial assistance through your school and/or through TWC. To find out how much financial assistance you could be eligible for, make sure to:

Credit Arrangements for UMBC Students

You can expect to earn the following amount of credits for your participation in the program.

Fall/Spring Credit: Up to 6 credits **Summer Credit:** Up to 6 credits

The amount of academic credit you earn will be determined and awarded by your school, so be sure to discuss this with your liaison prior to applying to the program.
