Bridges to Biotech is a collaboration between the University of Maryland Systems, Johns Hopkins University, the National Institutes of Health, and the Maryland Department of Commerce to provide senior STEM and PhD students and post-doctoral fellows with additional training and networking within the state industry to support their continuity in Maryland. 
If I can't participate this year, can I attend next year? Absolutely! The event is typically held August/September in person, but this year's unique circumstances required some additional planning.
