How to access Pearson courseware in 5 easy steps


## STEPS

1. Open “My Textbooks & Course Resources” tool from the “Course Materials Folder”
2. Click “Launch Courseware”.
3. Click the gold “Open MyLab & Mastering” button.
4. Sign In with your existing Pearson account OR create an account if you don’t already have one.
