Job Responsibilities

The Field Organizer will work to accomplish the following objectives:

- Turnout Democratic voters in Howard County by running an aggressive Get Out The Vote (GOTV) program
- Coordinate with Democratic campaigns to bolster their field operations
- Build and deploy a volunteer base by recruiting and motivating volunteers for canvassing, phone banking, and data entry, and ensure that volunteer databases are organized and kept up-to-date
- Help organize phone banks and canvasses, ensuring that all get-out-the-vote and commitment contact goals are met
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications

Successful applicants will demonstrate the following qualifications:

- Familiarity and experience with the Voter Activation Network (VAN)
- Previous experience as an organizer or campaign staffer is encouraged
- Strong time-management skills and work ethic
- Ability to spend long hours on the phone and canvassing
- Ability to adapt quickly and accomplish goals as set forth by the campaign
