Who is eligible to apply?

- New transfer students from Maryland community colleges with a 3.0 GPA
- Majoring in computer science, computer engineering, information systems, chemical or mechanical engineering
- Must be full-time student at UMBC
- US Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Must have financial need as determined by FAFSA



Scholarship Details:

- Multi-year scholarships will be awarded in Fall 2012, 2013, and 2014
- Scholarships of up to \$6,700 per year based on UMBC Financial Aid Office review
- Transfer Scholars must maintain a 3.0 GPA at UMBC.
- Required participation in CWIT community events focused on academic, professional, and leadership development.

What is the Scholar experience like?

As a T-SITE Scholar you will be part of the larger CWIT community of Scholars and Affiliates. Academic success and professional development are achieved through a number of program elements. Members of the CWIT community are encouraged to live on the CWIT Living Learning Community in the residence halls.

All T-SITE Scholars:

- Are assigned a faculty and peer mentor in their major;
- Explore career options, develop lifelong career management skills, and identify internships, and post-graduation jobs through professional development events and an assigned Industry mentor;
- Participate in a seminar specifically designed for transfer students;
- Meet regularly with a CWIT professional advisor to set goals and track individual progress;
- Develop leadership skills through involvement in student organizations and K-12 outreach.
