



Economics Pre-Doc Pipeline Workshop

Friday, September 15, 2023 – Virtual

A one-day virtual workshop to connect promising undergraduate students from universities around the country with pre-doctoral hiring institutions.

Please help identify promising undergraduates who are interested in PhDs in economics and related fields. Pre-doctoral fellowships are increasingly becoming a route for undergraduates to learn the ins and outs of research, develop their own interests in economic research, and boost preparation for graduate school.

Students who attend will learn about pre-doc positions and meet with economists, pre-doc managers, current pre-docs, and graduate admissions directors from participating institutions. There is no cost to attend.
