WHEN & WHERE:

- **Saturday, Feb. 25, 2023**, at the *FIRST* LEGO League Challenge State Championship at UMBC-Catonsville. Times vary by role.

VOLUNTEER ROLES:

- **Judges** interview and evaluate teams based on listed criteria and deliberate as a group to decide the teams most deserving for trophies. Both technical and non-technical skills welcome. Robotics background not required.
- **Referees** observes team robot performance, identifies rule violations, and assesses for scoring.
