

Health Insurance Enrollment Information

What items should I have with me for my enrollment session?:

- Social Security Number (or document number for legal immigrants who need insurance)
- Birthdates and general information about you and your family members who are also applying for health coverage
- Employer and income information for everyone in your family (ex. Paystubs, W-2 forms, or wage/tax statements)
- Policy numbers for any current health insurance
- Information about any job-related health insurance available to your family
