Scholarship Maintenance

Freshmen Merit Scholarship Maintenance

 **3.25 GPA**

Recipients must maintain a minimum 3.25 cumulative GPA each semester.

 **12 CREDITS**

Scholars must enroll and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per fall and spring semesters. This does not include audited courses.

**ACADEMIC
REVIEWS**

All recipients undergo academic review each semester to ensure they maintain cumulative GPA and enrollment requirements.

Transfer Merit Scholarship Maintenance



3.00 GPA

Recipients must maintain a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA each semester.



12 CREDITS

Scholars must enroll and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per fall and spring semesters. This does not include audited courses. *If enrolled between 6 and 11 credits, award will be prorated.*

All recipients undergo academic review each semester to ensure they maintain cumulative GPA and enrollment requirements.

Merit Scholarships are automatically renewable, provided students maintain the terms and conditions of their agreement.

Freshmen: 4 years

Fall and Spring semesters only.

Transfers: 2 years

1. Visit the first sign-in with the user name here and password (do not be afraid you [forgot your login name!](#))
2. Complete the General Application
3. Once submitted, if applicable, you will be notified if you are eligible to apply for additional opportunities. For Scholarship see below.

Automatic Scholarships: Once you complete your General Application, you will be matched with scholarships for which you automatically qualify based on criteria reported only - no further action is required. All students who qualify will be automatically notified of these opportunities. Qualifying does not guarantee you will receive a scholarship only that you are now eligible to be considered for one.

Apply to Scholarships: There are scholarships in which you do not automatically qualify based on the General Application.

To see a list of scholarships that may meet additional criteria, you need to create an individual profile.

1. Select "Recommendations" under "Opportunities."
2. Submit any additional essays, recommendations, etc. as required by further communication.

Award Amount: The number and award amount of scholarships are for general information purposes only and should not be considered a guarantee of what you will receive if awarded. Scholarship amounts may be based on student individual ability, needs, awards, and other factors.
