



# Top 10 Tips

- 1. Start early!
- 2. Tap into your network
  - a. Major
  - b. Employer
  - c. Coaches
  - d. Friends
- 3. Look beyond UMBC
  - a. Fastweb
  - b. Companies related to major

#### 4. Go Local

- a. Try searching "scholarships + your state/city"
- 5. More work = fewer applications = better chances
  - a. \$/hour rate better than job pay
- 6. Satisfy all the requirements
- 7. Proofread
- 8. Write a great essay
- 9. Do your research
- 10. Keep your eye on the prize! Don't give up.

- $\geq$  3.20 cumulative GPA
- 2021-2022 FAFSA on file
  - Or explanation of why it is not completed
