MERIT SCHOLARSHIP MAINTENANCE

3.25 GPA

Recipients must maintain a minimum 3.25 cumulative GPA each semester.

12 CREDITS

Scholars must enroll and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per fall and spring semesters.

This does not include audited courses.

ACADEMIC REVIEWS

All recipients undergo academic review each semester to ensure they maintain cumulative GPA and enrollment requirements.

Merit Scholarships are automatically renewable, provided students maintain the terms and conditions of their agreement.

Freshmen: 4 years

Fall and Spring semesters only.

Transfers: 2 years




