• To reevaluate and monitor institutions to ensure compliance with standards for accreditation, requirements of affiliation, policies and procedures, and applicable federal regulatory requirements in accordance with federal regulation



Why Accreditation?

- To strengthen and sustain higher education, making it worthy of public confidence, and minimizing the scope of external control.
- To demonstrate institutions' commitment to continuous self-assessment



- 4% Private (For-Profit)













 Enhancing our Carnegie R1 classification while maintaining our commitment to a highquality liberal arts educational experience


