What we will do:

- Promote Distinguished Speaker series (hear tapes of academic giants such as Robert Dahl, Fareed Zakaria, and Lani Guiner and discuss them with your peers)
- Submit proposals for Activity Grants (and here YOU control what you want to do with your peers)
- Participate in competitions for scholarships for graduate schools, for Pi Sigma Alpha's Washington Internship Program, and for essay contests (both class papers and honors theses)
- Host the second annual in-house undergraduate research conference for political science majors to showcase their work

Who can join:

Undergraduates must meet the following criteria: They must have completed at least one-half the credits required by their institution for the baccalaureate degree; they must have completed at least ten semester-credits of work in political science including at least one upper-division course, with an average grade of B or higher in those courses; they must have achieved an overall GPA placing them in the top one-third of their whole class (e.g., junior or senior class). They need not be political science majors to qualify for membership.

Junior requirement: 3.08 Senior requirement: 3.31

What you have to do:

- Fill out the attached application form
- Pay mandatory \$35 lifetime initiation fee to Dr. Forestiere
- Pay an additional \$17 for cords, \$17 for medallion or \$30 for both (for graduation) not required
- Pay an additional \$1 for a pin not required

Everything – membership, cords, medallion, and pin = \$66
