- American Dental Education Association Associated American Dental School Application Service
- The online application for dental schools
 - Verifies Transcript
 - Calculates GPA
 - Application is sent to chosen schools for review

BEFORE YOU APPLY

- All pre-requisite classes (varies slightly per school)
- ❖ The DAT
- Shadowing
- Secured letters of recommendation
 - 2 Science Professors
 - > 1 Dentist
 - > 10ther
- Personal Statement
- Researching/Picking schools
 - Application is sent to every school you choose
 - First school- \$264
 - > All other schools-\$115

IDEAL TIMELINE

- April/May:
 - Research schools
 - Take the DAT
 - Order transcripts
 - Secure letters of recommendations
 - Complete personal statement
- Beginning of June:
 - Submit application (the earlier, the better)
- July-August:
 - Complete secondary applications
- Fall/Spring term
 - > Interviews
 - Offers of acceptances/notice of denials starting December

THE APPLICATION

- ♦ 2024-2025 cycle dates (new cycle TBA)
 - May 14th-Application opens
 - June 4th-Submission opens
- Separated into 4 sections
 - Personal information
 - Academic History
 - Supporting Information
 - Program Material
- Prepare; some sections are lengthy



PERSONAL INFORMATION

- ❖ Biography Information: Your name, age, place of birth, etc.
- Contact Information: Address, phone number, email
- Citizenship Information
- Environmental Factors: Academics, upbringing, connections to dentistry
- ❖ Parents/Guardians: Academics, occupation
- Race & Ethnicity
- Other Information: DENTPIN (for DAT), matriculation year into school, criminal/academic infraction status, manual dexterity, COVID-19 impact (optional)

ACADEMIC HISTORY

- Colleges attended
 - Attach official transcripts
- High School attended
- Manual transcript entry
- Standardized test
 - DAT entry: date taken, score

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- Evaluations: Letter of Recommendations/HPEC packet
- Experiences: Jobs, shadowing, extracurriculars
 - Dates, descriptions, number of weeks/hours per week
 - Star 6 most important
- ❖ Achievements: Awards, Honors, Scholarships
 - Organization, description, date issued
- ❖ Licenses: Hygienist/Dental Assistant, Dental tech, etc
- ❖ Personal Statement: 4500 character limit

PROGRAM MATERIAL

- Individual requirements from each school (varies)
- Prerequisite classes
 - Manually assign from your transcript
- Supplemental questions (only some)
 - Why do you want to go to OUR school?
 - What do you want to do after dental school?
 - Ties to school (applied before, undergrad applied, family members)
 - Short essays (personal mission statement, facing ethical dilemma, memorable dental experience, etc)

Dossier - Interfolio

- This is a portal you can use to confidentially store your LOR's (if not using HPEC) and later upload them to your application
- Make sure to ask professors at least 8 weeks before the date you plan to submit your application
- Once they agree, you can enter their name/email in the portal and it will send an automated email instructing them on how to submit

UMBC HPEC

- If you are planning to start dental school in Fall 2026, the HPEC application opens in December 2024
