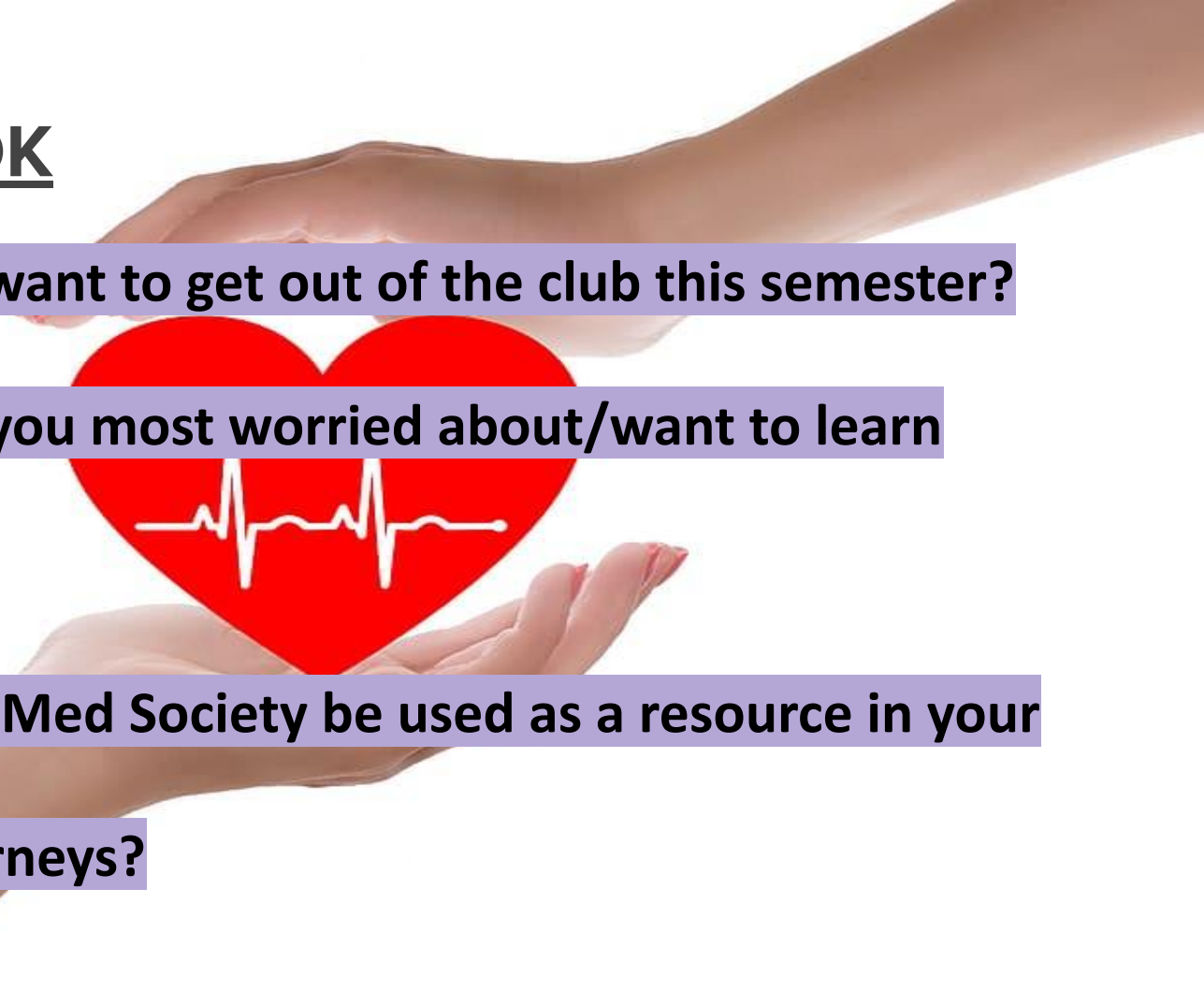
OUTSIDE RESOURCES
