## Directions for Applying:

2. Fill out this application electronically (please type everything and send it to sanab1@umbc.edu - we will not be accepting paper applications).
3. Once your application has been turned in, you should receive an email confirmation stating that your application has been accepted. If you do not hear back from us within two days, please send your application in again.
4. After applications have been reviewed, you will receive a confirmation email notifying whether or not if you are allowed to run for the applied position(s).
5. There will be a google form sent out to all members, which will include the officers running, a written speech, and a chance to vote. If you are running unopposed, you will automatically obtain the position.
6. Once chosen to be an officer, you must attend the next officer meeting with the former executive board.
7. Late applications will NOT be accepted and failure to comply with the conditions listed above can result in withdrawal of the officer position.
8. For President and Vice-President positions: you must have been a member of the UMBC Pre-Pharmacy Society for at least 1 year.
9. Requirements: Minimum total of 3 meetings attended and participated in at least two fundraiser/community service this Fall semester.

## President

In order to run for this position, the person must have been an active member for at least a year.

- Organizing board and club meetings as well as registering the club
- Coordinating with and delegating working amongst all board members
- Working with board members to make final executive and financial decisions
- Using good oral and written communication skills
- Ensure all aspects of the club functions smoothly, effectively, and efficiently


## Vice-President

In order to run for this position, the person must have been an active member for at least a year. The vice-president is responsible for helping the president with anything he or she needs as it arises.

- Help the president run meetings
- Help delegate tasks
- Become the substitute President if needed
- Is expected to be one of the first people to help any board member in any task
- Create membership application forms, sign-up sheets, sign-in sheets, etc.


## Secretary

In order to run for this position, the person must have been an active member for at least 1 semester.

- Keeping track of attendance of a large number of members to make sure members meet the attendance quota
- Updating the email list server
- Collecting attendance sheets from meetings, fundraisers, and community service events
- Keeps track of the minutes for board meetings
- Must be organized and attentive to details
- Be able to send reminder emails at least twice a week about the weekly emails.


## Treasurer

In order to run for this position, the person must have been an active member for at least 1 semester.
The treasurer maintains all the finances within the club but also has other roles such as:

- Treasurer makes deposits and withdraws money when the club needs to
- The treasurer is also in charge of reimbursing the officers or members for any money they spend on the club
- Being responsible for all fundraisers, both raising money for non-profit organizations and raising money for the club.


## Events Committee

In order to run for this position, the person must have been an active member for at least 1 semester.
The events committee consists of two people (the special events coordinator and the assistant coordinator) who will help the president and vice president in planning activities. The assistant coordinator must not be in their final year at UMBC when assuming this position. Their duties consist of:

- Obtaining guest speakers (preferable professionals from various aspects of the pharmacy field)
- Finding local community service activities for the club (i.e. feeding the homeless, helping underprivileged children, etc.)
- Networking and partnering with other student organizations on programs
- Scheduling events as well as emailing reminders to guest speakers and sending them thank you letters


## Public Relations

In order to run for this position, the person must have been an active member for at least 1 semester.
The public relation advertises Pre-Pharmacy Society to the campus by:

- Forming fliers and posting them
- Photographing events, meetings, and service opportunities
- Assisting the Secretary in maintaining the website/Facebook
