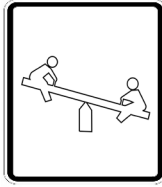


Tulane University Health Policy Case Competition



Announcing the 4th Annual Tulane Health Policy Case Competition! This competition is open to any current undergraduate student interested in health policy. You and a team of two of your peers will develop a response to a case prompt that proposes an alteration to current health policy at the international, national, state, or local level.

This year's prompt asks you to develop an effective homelessness policy. The city of New Orleans has asked you to tackle this burgeoning crisis, and policymakers working in this space are eager to hear your solutions.

Presentations will be judged on:

Feasibility. Is the policy legally and financially viable? Have implementation challenges been addressed?

Effectiveness. What are the magnitudes of health changes from the policy?

Evidence. Is the policy supported by the data? Has it been implemented successfully in other contexts?

Slides due – Mon, Oct 23, 2023

Finalists present via Zoom – Sat, Oct 28, 2023

Award:

\$1000 cash & \$10,000 scholarship* to the Tulane MPH in Health Policy to each member of the 1st place team

*Scholarships are limited to students enrolled full-time in the Health Policy concentration of the Master of Public Health at the Tulane School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine. The award will be distributed \$5,000 per semester. The award will be disbursed in the academic year following winning the competition.

Entry in the competition is open to any current undergraduate student.
