Legislative Intern Program

Paid Internships

The Maryland General Assembly's Legislative Intern Program offers college students the opportunity to provide research and staff assistance to legislators while gaining firsthand experience in Maryland's legislative process.

Internships are held in person during session at the State House in Annapolis from January 11 through April 16, 2027. Interns work a minimum of two days per week in a legislator's office, committee, caucus, or delegation, and attend required programming on either Wednesday or Thursday.

Eligibility

- Currently enrolled in a Maryland college
- Sophomore standing or above (*high school graduation of 2025 or earlier*)
- 3.0 GPA or higher
- Must earn credit for the internship
- Must work at least two full days weekly for the duration of the internship.
