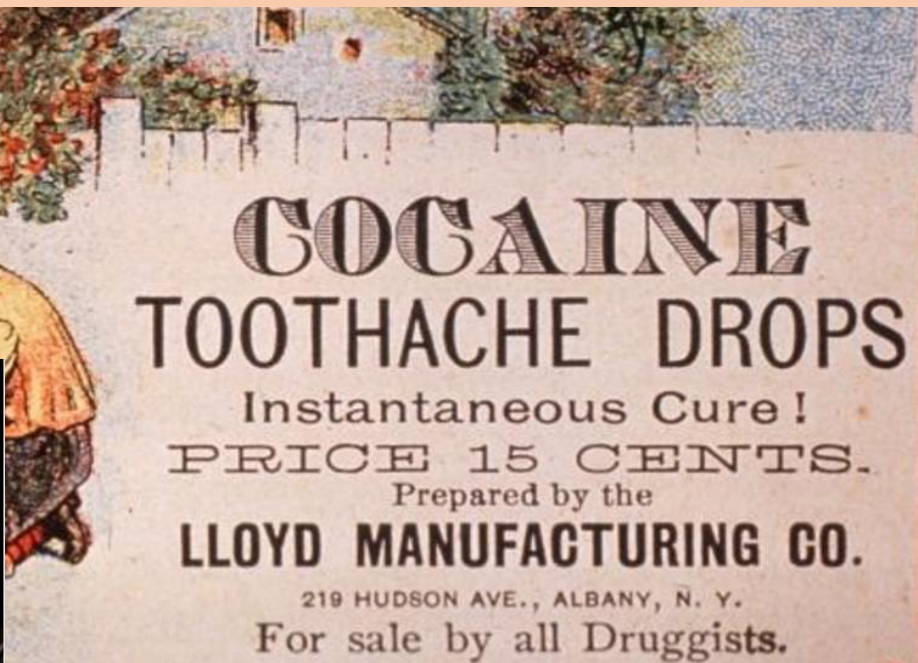
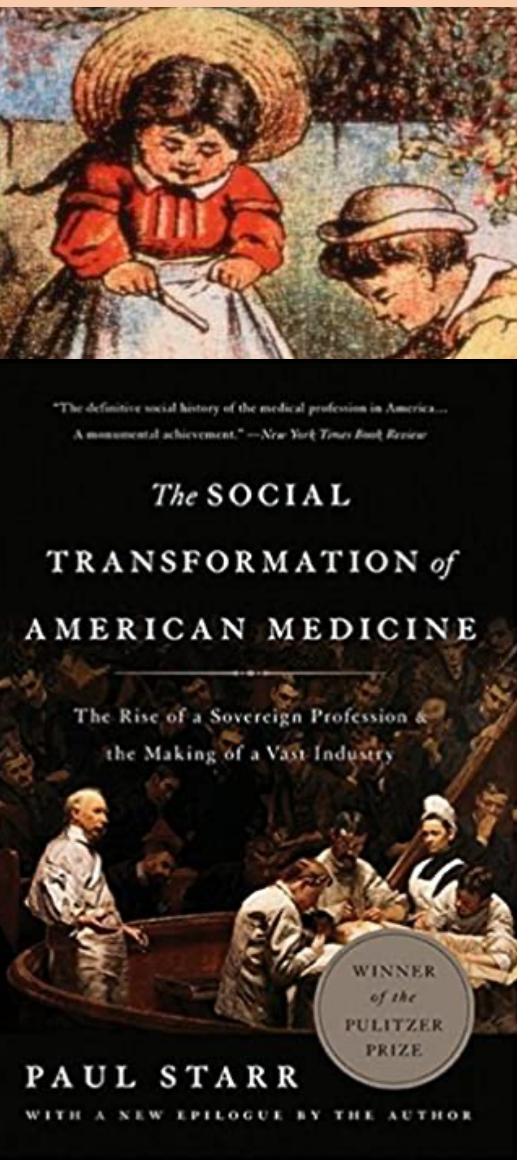

- *Activism and the HIV/AIDS Crisis in the 1980s*

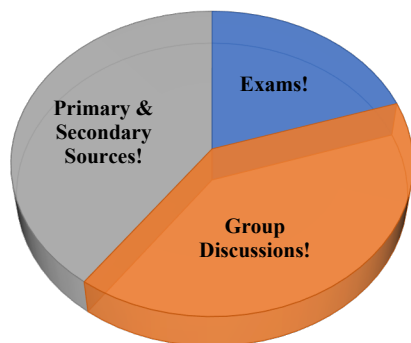
Think critically about the creation of our modern medical industry including:
