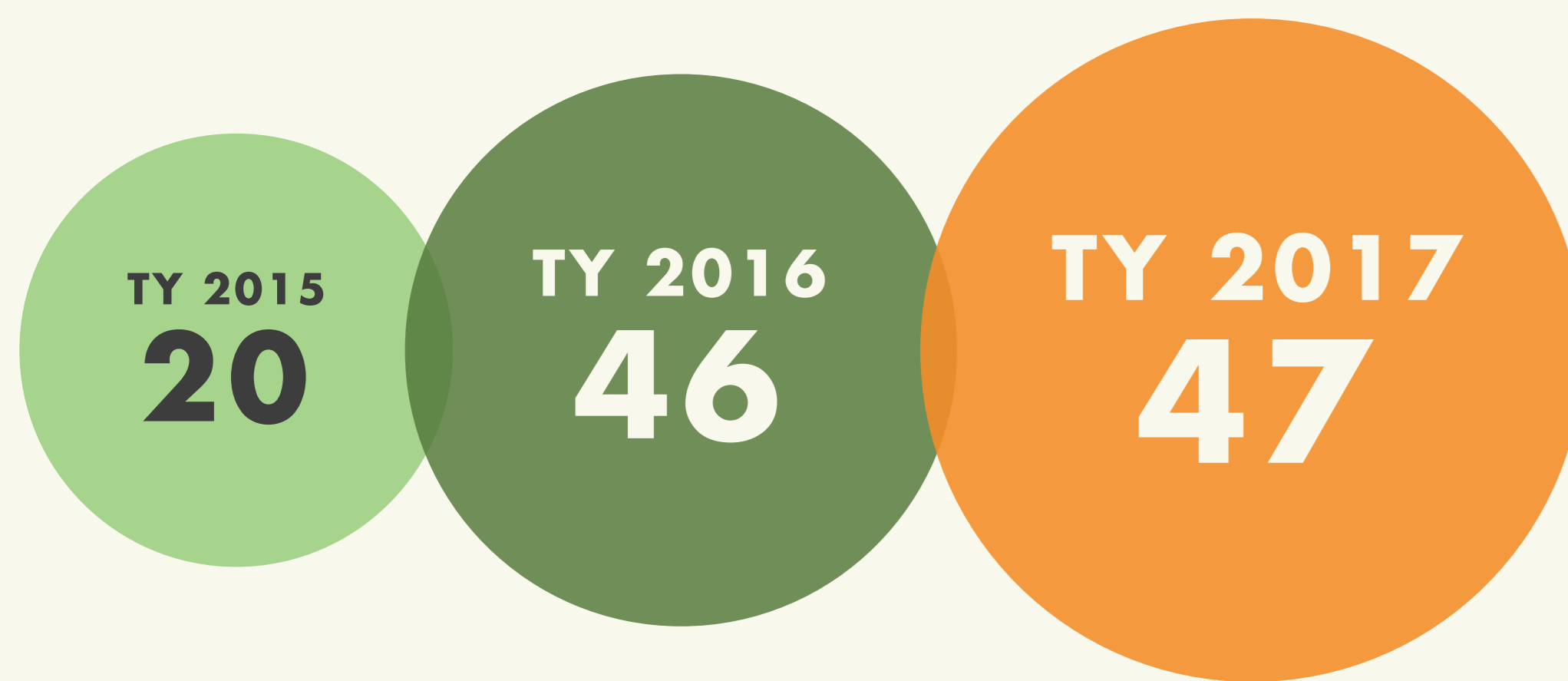

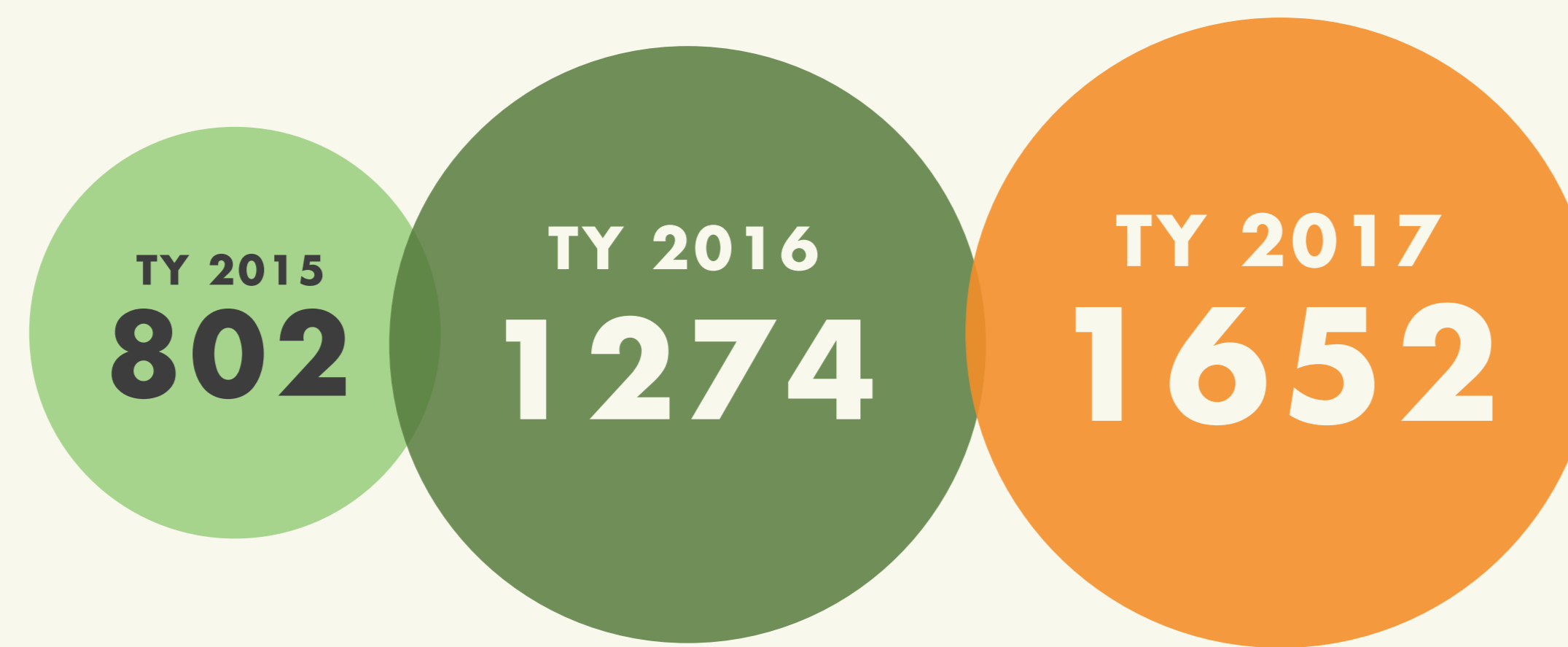
## — PROGRAM INFORMATION —

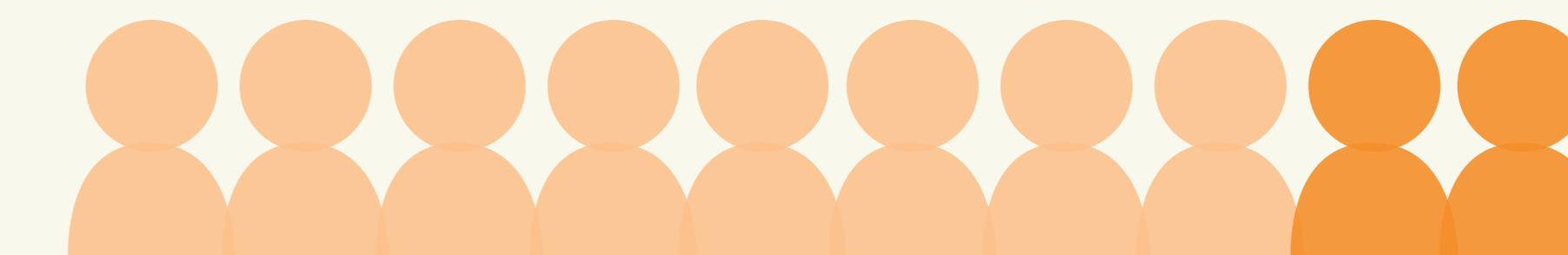

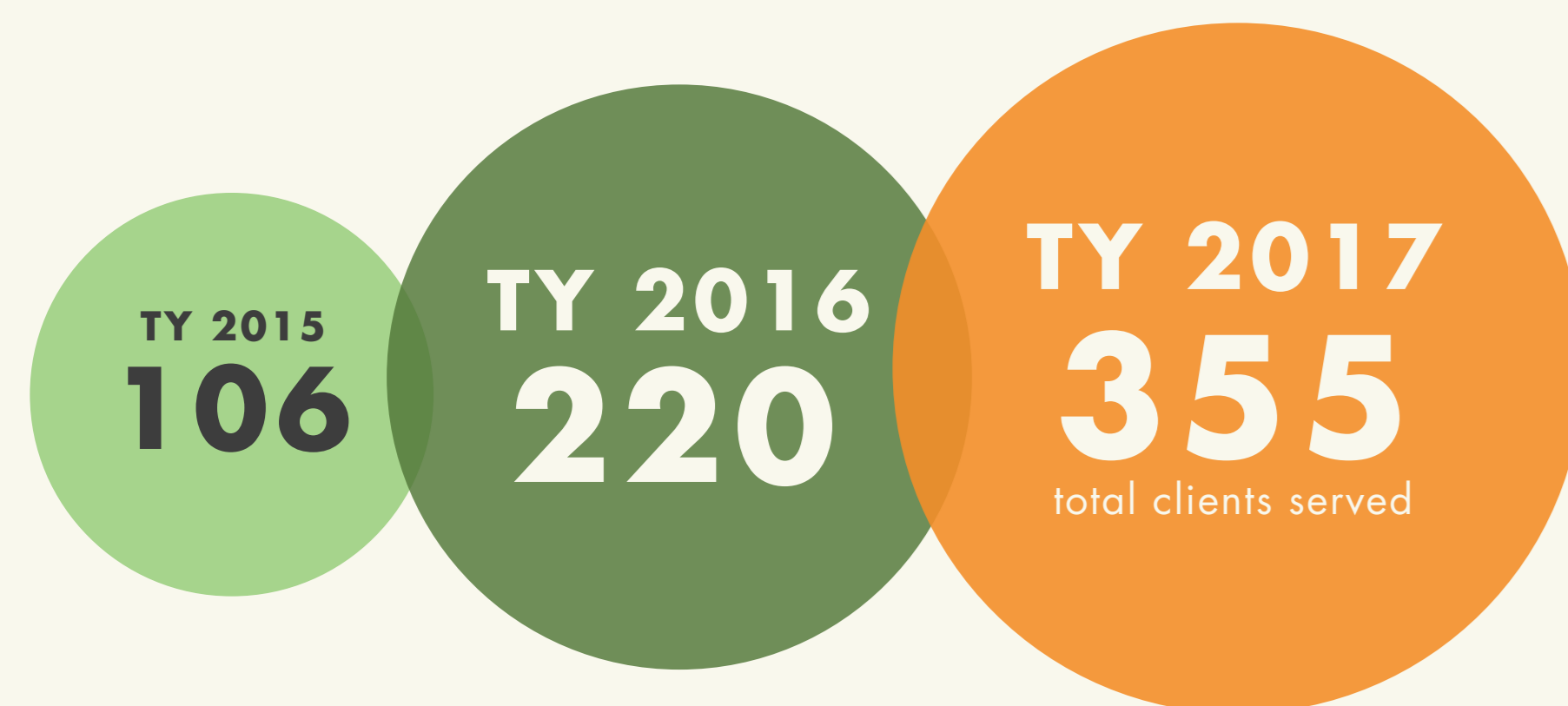

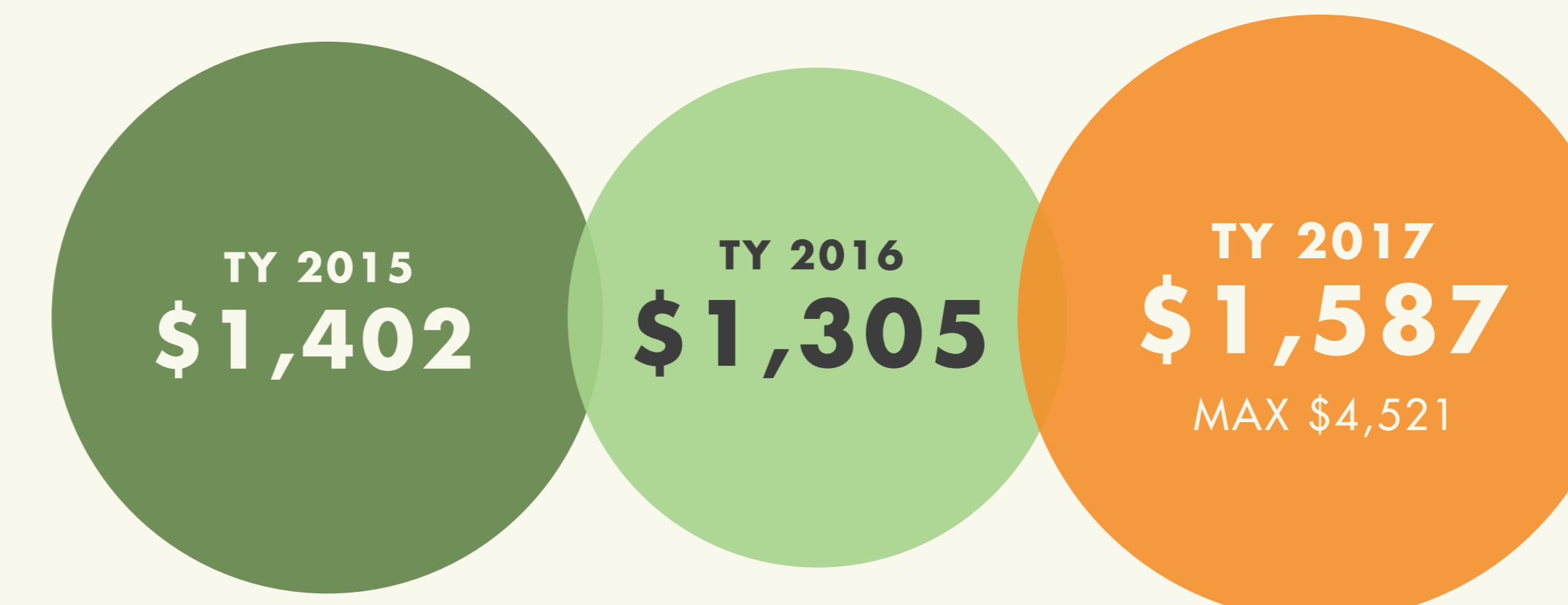

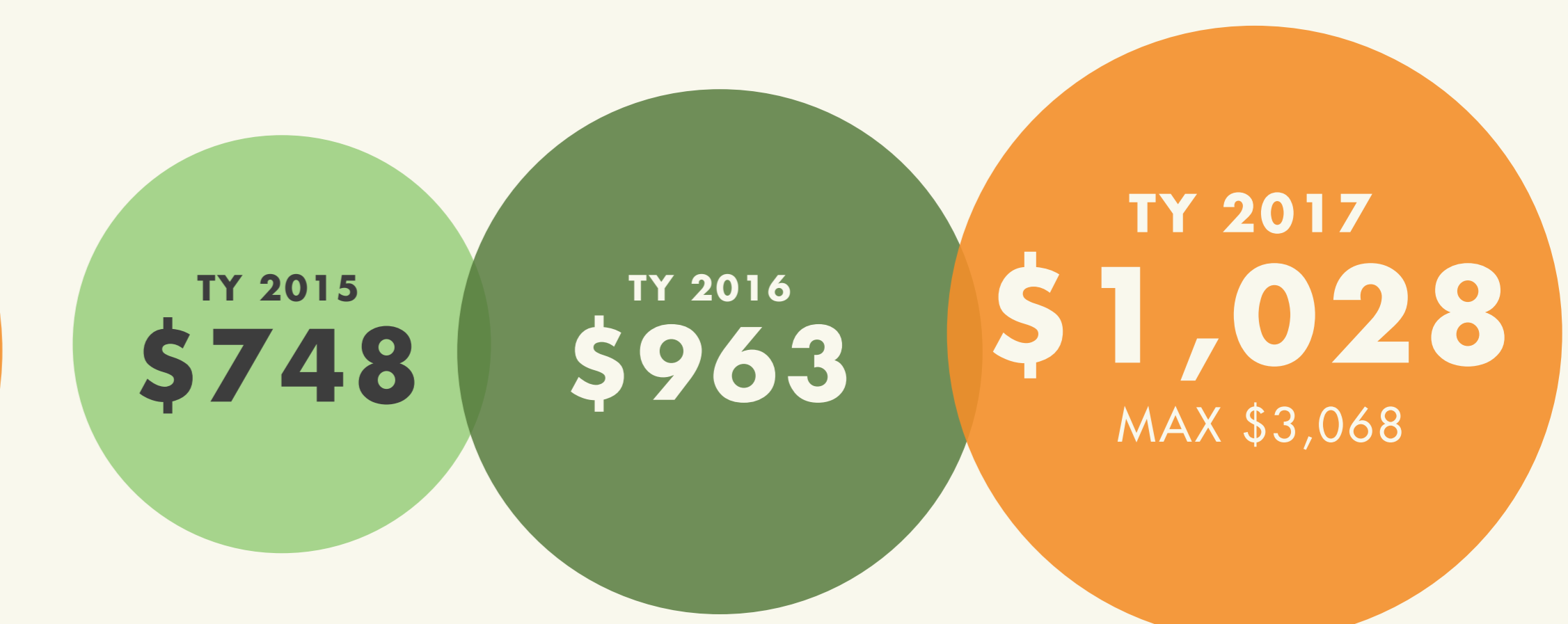

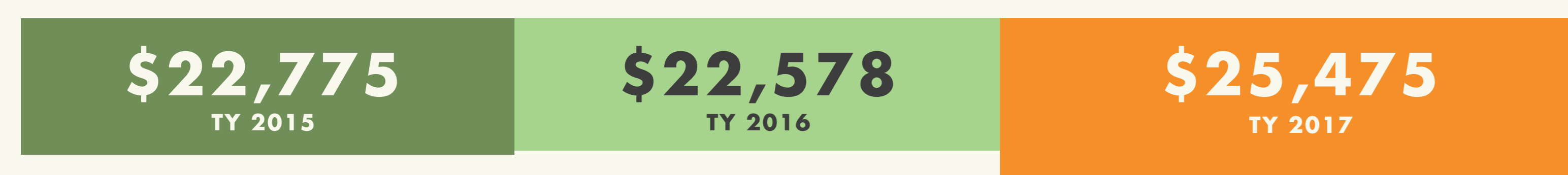
AVERAGE EARNED INCOME CREDIT



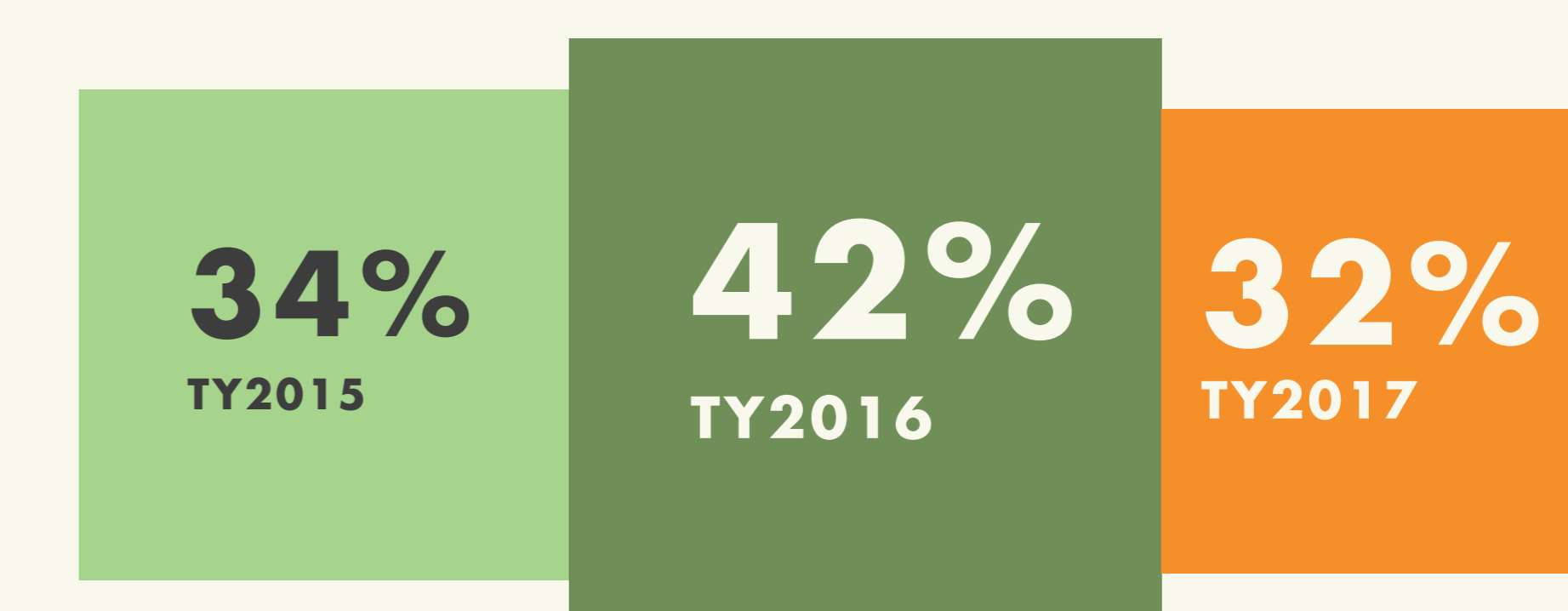
AVERAGE EDUCATION CREDIT
