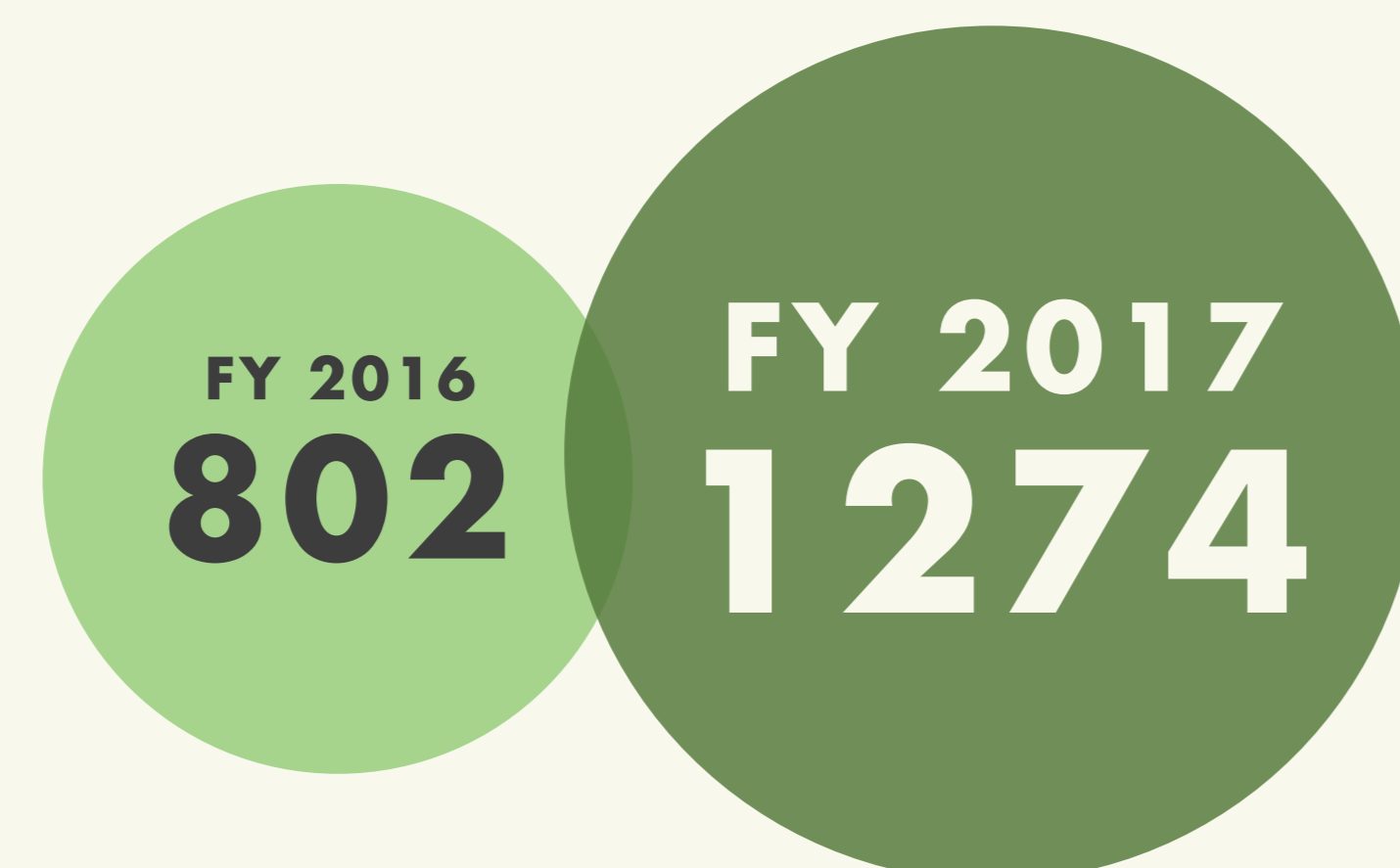
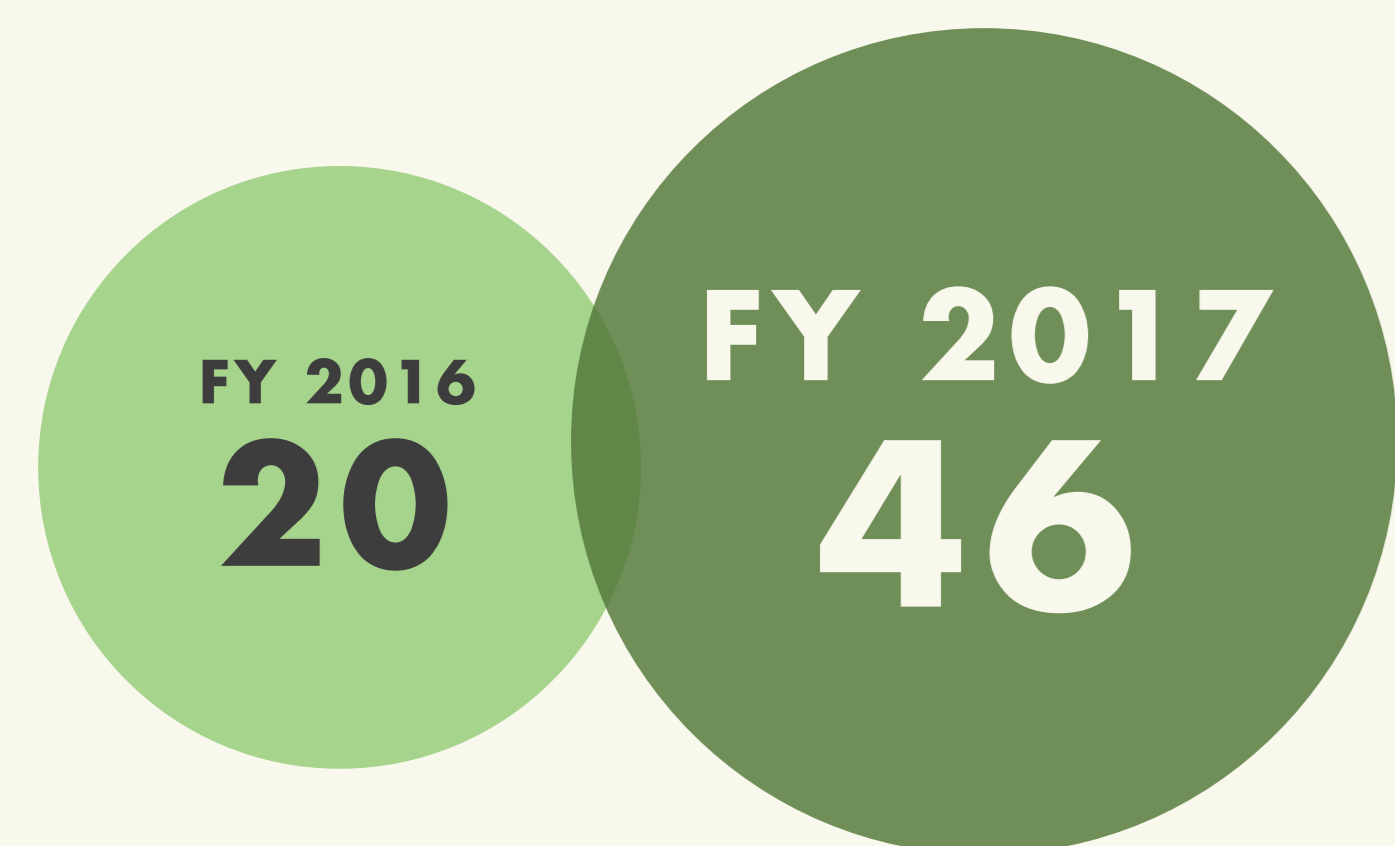


## — PROGRAM INFORMATION —

AVERAGE ADJUSTED GROSS INCOME OF CLIENTS



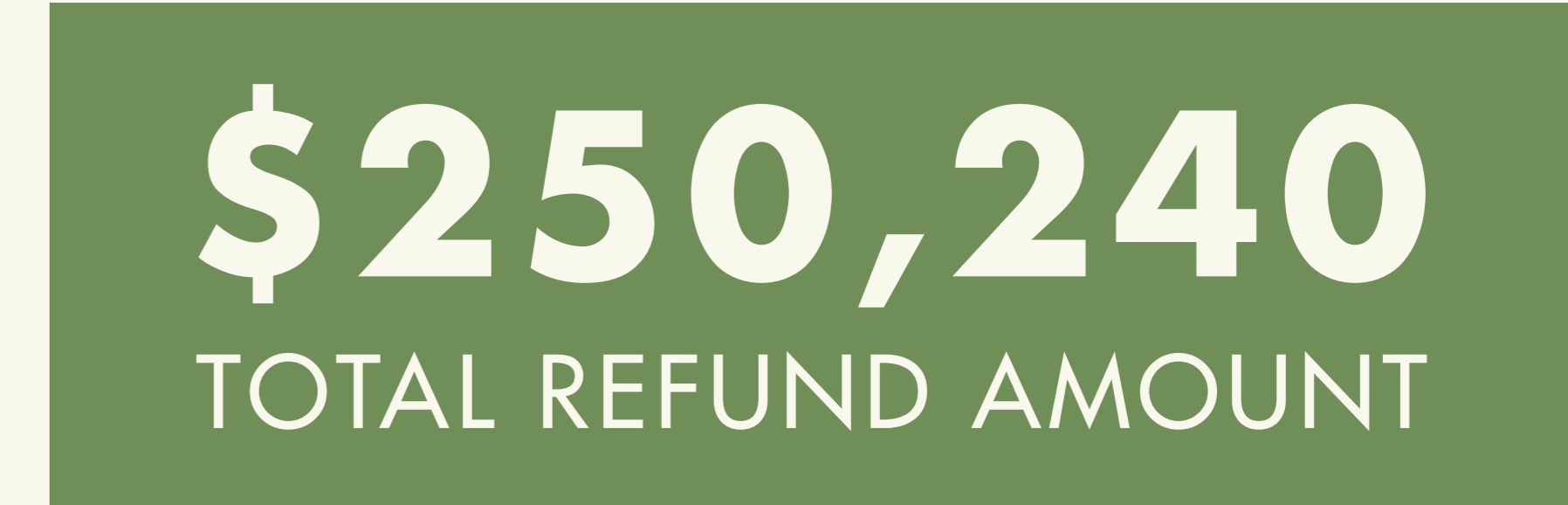
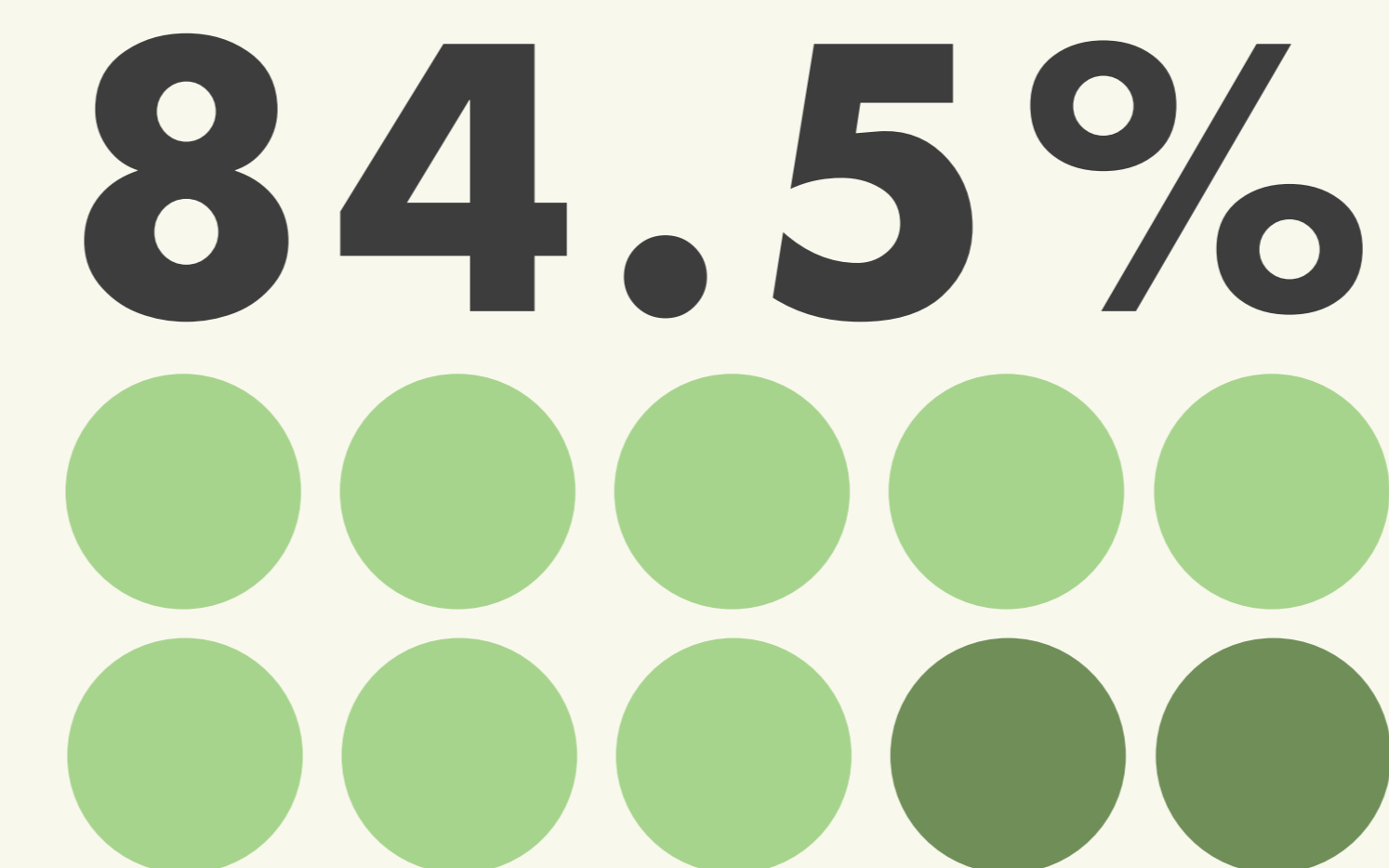

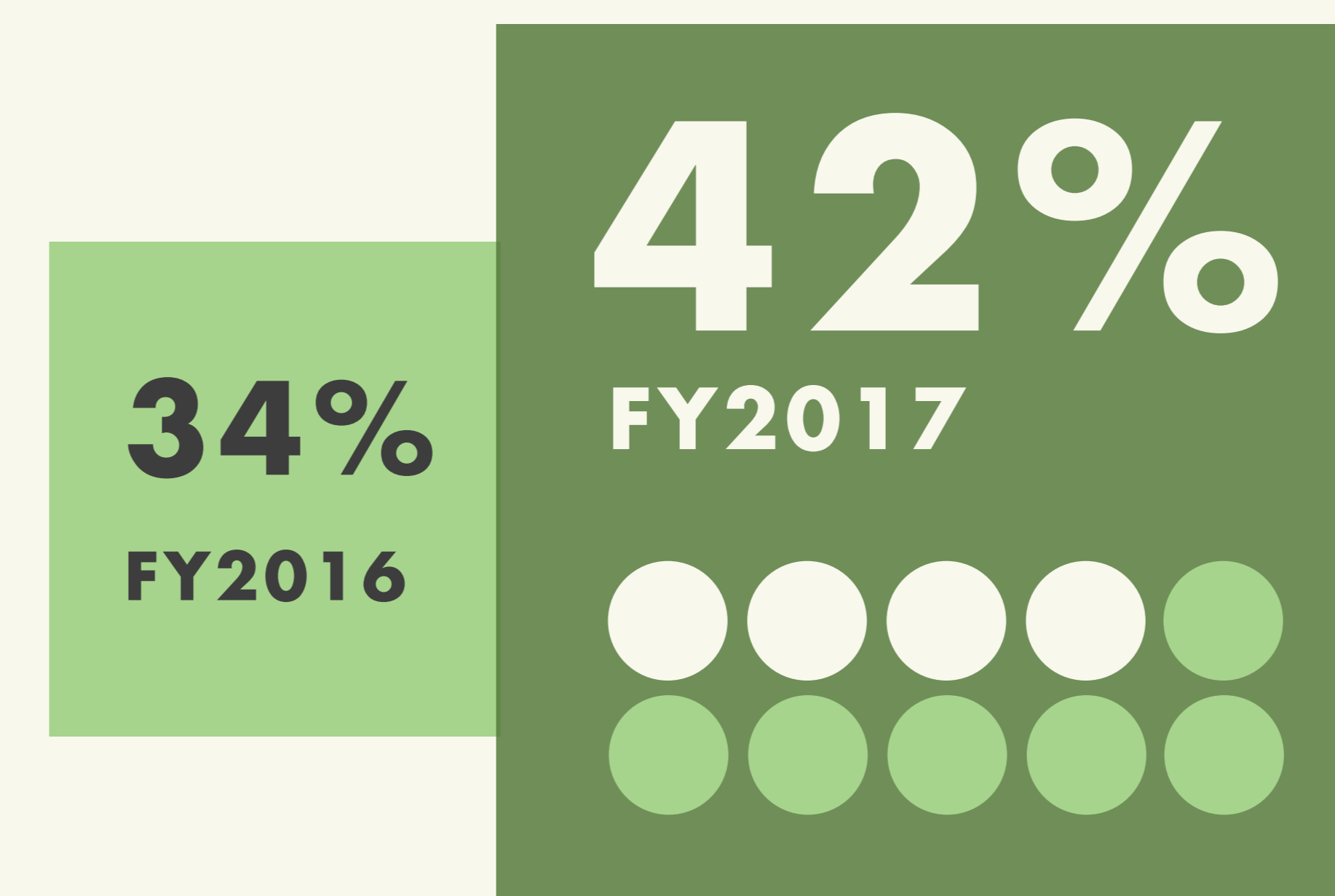
CLIENTS WHO GOT A REFUND



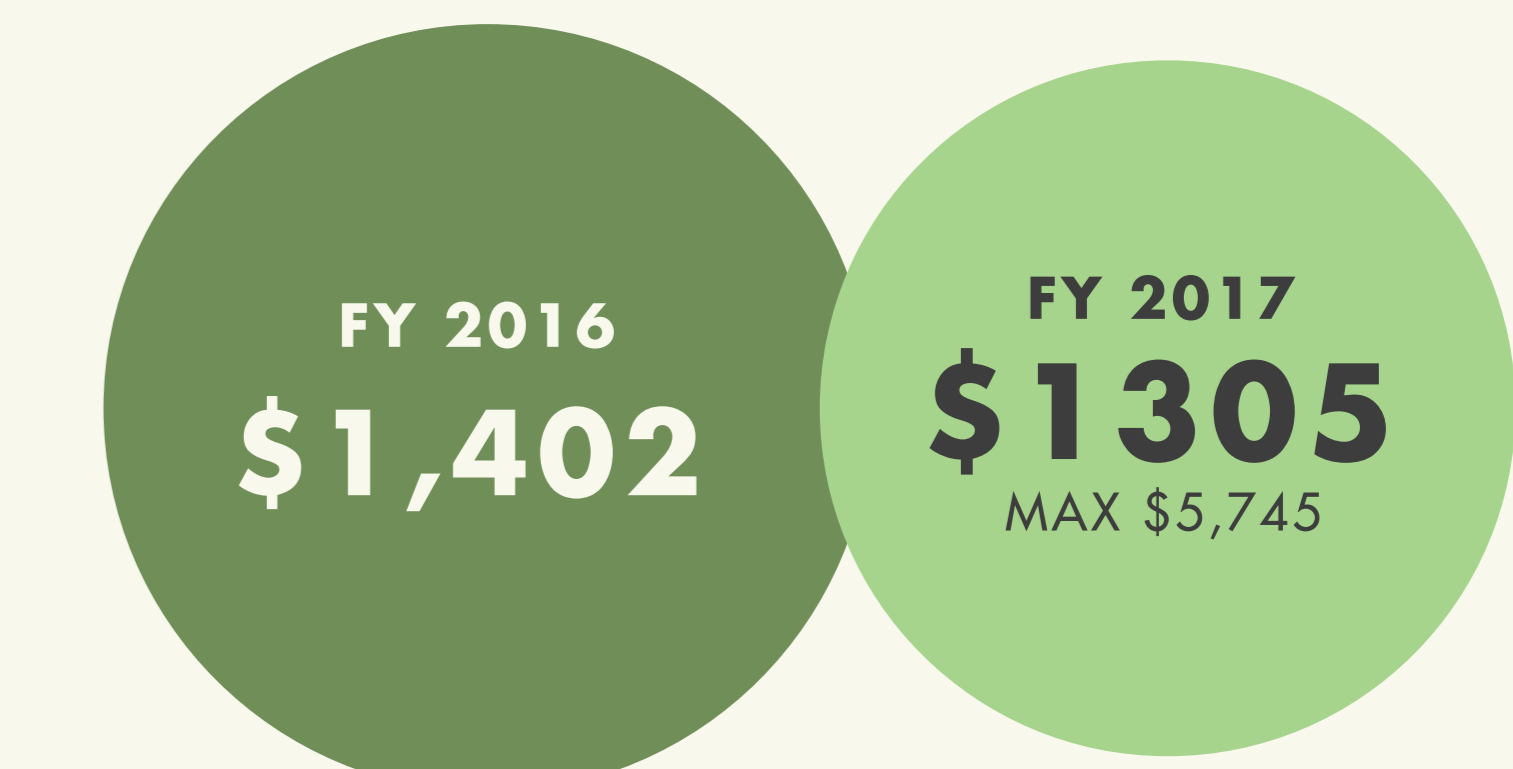
AVERAGE EDUCATION CREDIT
