PAID INTERNSHIPS FOR ALL MAJORS

Work in Washington, D.C. or other major U.S. cities

Whether you're seeking an internship with the federal government or in the corporate sector, the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (HACU) provides you the opportunity to graduate with career experience.

Best of all, you gain this experience while living in the nation's capital or cities like Atlanta, Albuquerque, Chicago, Dallas, Denver, Los Angeles, Seattle, St. Louis, New York City, or other locations nationwide.

The HACU National Internship Program (HNIP) has been a premier student program for over 20 years, recognized as the largest internship program with Hispanic participation.

Eligibility

Interns spend ten or fifteen weeks at their assigned internships. To qualify, you must:

- Be enrolled in a degree-seeking program at a college or university in the U.S. or Puerto Rico
- Have completed freshman year
- Be an undergraduate or graduate student
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Be authorized or eligible to work by law in the U.S.

Federal Intern Pay

Federal intern compensation is determined by academic level at the time of application. Pay is based on 40 hours per week:

- Sophomore/Junior \$470
- Senior \$500
- Graduate \$570

Corporate Intern Pay

Corporate interns will be paid salaries similar to federal interns based on 40 hours per week, at minimum.

Travel and Housing Information

- Round-trip airfare for federal interns is arranged and paid by HACU. Prior approval may be requested by interns who wish to arrange their own transportation and receive reimbursement for expenses.
- Housing arrangements are managed by HACU. Federal interns pay for housing through payroll deductions. Federal interns can choose to arrange their own housing.
- HACU and corporations will coordinate with corporate interns on housing and travel arrangements, whenever applicable. Corporate interns may make their own housing and non-airfare travel arrangements. Corporate interns pay for their housing through electronic funds transfer.

Academic Credit

Interns may be eligible to receive academic credit. HACU can facilitate the process to ensure the necessary documentation is submitted.

deadlines are as follows:

Spring 2013 Internship dates:

January 10 - April 27
Application deadline: November 16, 2012

Summer 2013 Internship dates:

May 31 - August 10 (regular dates)
June 17 - August 24 (quarter dates) *
Application deadline: March 1, 2013

* Later start date in the Summer Session is only
applicable to students who attend institutions that
operate on a quarter calendar.

Fall 2013

August 22 - December 9
Application opens: March 1, 2013
Application deadline: June 14, 2013
