Dr. Geoffrey Curran is Director of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) Center for Implementation Research and is Professor of Pharmacy Practice (College of Pharmacy) and Psychiatry (College of Medicine). He is also a Research Health Scientist at Central Arkansas Veterans Healthcare System. He has served as PI on numerous VA and NIH-funded implementation research projects, and established the concept of the “hybrid effectiveness-implementation design” which is now in broad use. He served as one of 10 national experts on an NIH Dissemination and Implementation Research Design and Methods Working Group with the goal of developing guidance and tools for selecting implementation research designs.
