Program Overview

STEAM Innovations is an 8-week virtual exchange program designed for undergraduate students interested in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math). This program connects participants from Algeria, Iraq, Saudi Arabia, and the USA to foster a global learning community. Designed to empower 700 participants with the tools necessary for navigating future STEAM careers, this program enhances cross-cultural understanding, critical skills, and a comprehensive global outlook.

Educational Objectives

- STEAM Discovery: Explore a variety of STEAM disciplines and gain hands-on experience.
- Career Planning: Identify strengths and set ambitious career goals.
- Civic Engagement: Develop leadership skills and positively impact the community.
- Entrepreneurship: Sharpen problem-solving and creative thinking skills; transform innovative ideas into practical solutions.
- Collaborative Project: Work in teams to address a global challenge.

- Global Collaboration: Connect with undergraduate students from Algeria, Iraq, Saudi Arabia, and the USA.
- Comprehensive Curriculum: Includes modules on STEAM, career planning, civic engagement, and entrepreneurship.
