

FREE short-term bike sharing program for UMBC students, faculty & staff

The Retrieverfleet program works like checking out a basketball—present your UMBC I.D. at the RAC checkout location. You will need to sign a checkout log and contract to receive the combination to your bike lock. Return the bike and accessories to the RAC. The program is free of charge unless damage is done to the equipment due to negligence or vandalism.

Benefits of taking advantage of Retrieverfleet:

- Provides convenient transportation around campus and the surrounding college town without relying on a car or bus
- Lowers greenhouse gas emissions
- Fun exercise for physical fitness
- Lessens cost of fuel
- Reduces traffic congestion

The fleet is composed of 6 Diamondback bikes equipped with a water bottle holder, bike lock, and a helmet (for mandatory use).

Bike sizing is not an exact science, but a general rule of thumb is as follows:

Your height	Your inseam length	Bike frame size
5'5" and smaller	26" and smaller	15 inch
5'6" and taller	27" and longer	19 inch

The bike seat is adjustable, and the seat height should allow your knee to have a slight bend when extended.

You can check out a bike for single-day use—it must be returned at least 15 minutes prior to closing to avoid late fees. Long-term bike rentals are also available at the following overnight prices: \$17 for each additional day If the bike and accessories are not returned at least 15 minutes prior to closing on the same day of check-out, a late fee of \$17 will be charged to your myUMBC account. If the bike is lost, destroyed, or not returned after 10 days, you will be charged the retail cost of the bike and accessories. If a bike is returned dirty and requires additional cleaning, a \$10 cleaning fee will be charged to your myUMBC account. Always remember to LOCK your bike when left unattended. If your bike is stolen, contact the UMBC Police Department immediately at 410-455-5555 to report a bike theft. Inform the RAC manager on duty that you have filed a police report. To report a problem with the bike you have checked out, please return all equipment to the RAC and notify the manager on duty of the problem. To use the RAC air pump, transport your bike to the 1st floor using the elevator. Other Retrieverfleet policies: • Renter assumes all risk and responsibilities of injuries sustained during the rental. Riding while intoxicated is prohibited. • Rental equipment is only to be used by the renter.
