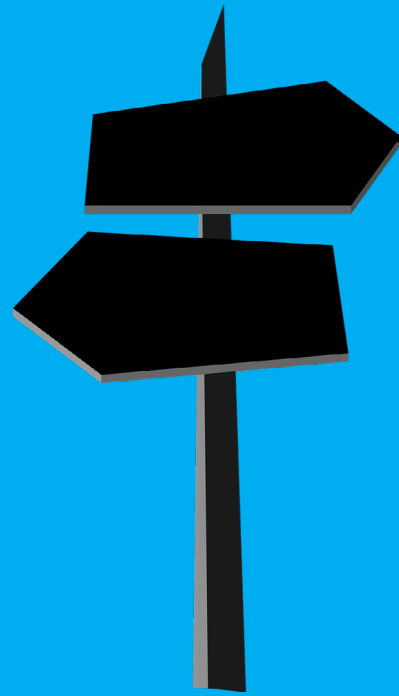


Having Immigrant Parents: Navigating Multicultural Identities
