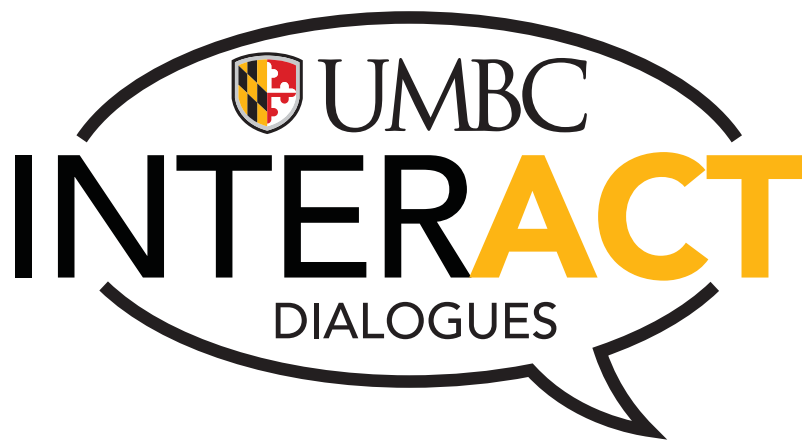




WHAT IS INTERACT?

Interact is a four-week program for first year undergraduate students to **introduce dialogue skills required to engage in difficult conversations, engage across difference, and foster meaningful connections.**

Participants will develop skills connected to competencies for dialogic community building including **critical self-reflection, generous listening, cultural storytelling, and loving accountability.**

Through weekly 90-minute sessions in small, co-facilitated groups of 10–15 students, participants will learn and practice the necessary skills to become **inclusive leaders and engaged community members.**
