About the Project

The Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) is working with Baltimore County to identify the investments needed to create better transit connections at Rolling Road and US-40 (Giant Food and Walmart Shopping Center) in Catonsville. We need your help to better understand what kinds of improvements would make the current bus stop better - whether it's making it more comfortable for people transferring between routes, making it safer for people arriving or departing this stop on foot or by bike, or anything else that would improve your experience.

Project Goals

MTA aims to accomplish the follow goals through improvements to the Catonsville Transit Hub:



Improved bus stop amenities, such as:

- Seating
- Shelters and shade
- Sidewalk space



Safer and more accessible pedestrian infrastructure, such as:

- Better lighting
- Bicycle paths and parking
- Wayfinding signage



Enhanced bus operations, such as:

- Dedicated bus bays
- Reducing conflicts with car traffic
- Operator facilities
