Spice and Wolf

Traveling merchant Kraft Lawrence continues his northward journey with wolf goddess Holo, who is in search of her lost home of Yoitsu. However, the road to Yoitsu is a bumpy one filled with many troubles—he and the goddess will also have to consider precarious and risky business deals as Lawrence strives to achieve his dream of becoming a shopowner.

Vivy: Fluorite Eye's Song

An AI named Matsumoto appears before Vivy, the world's first autonomous humanoid AI. Matsumoto's mission is to rewrite history together with Vivy, in order to stop the war between AI and humans that will happen one century later.

Run with the Wind

Kakeru, a former elite runner at high school, is chased for stealing food. He is saved by a Kansai university student Haiji, who is also a runner. Haiji persuades Kakeru to live in the old apartment "Chikuseisou" where he plans to team up with fellow residents to enter Hakone Ekiden Marathon, one of the most prominent university races in Japan. Kakeru soon finds out that all of the residents except for Haiji and himself are complete novices.

Psycho-Pass

Cyberpunk anime where the MC is an inspiring detective in a government where people are prosecuted based on an algorithm deciding how likely they are to commit a crime. Will note it's pretty gory at times and there's a very uncomfortable scene on episode 11 around 19 minutes in but it's amazing otherwise.
