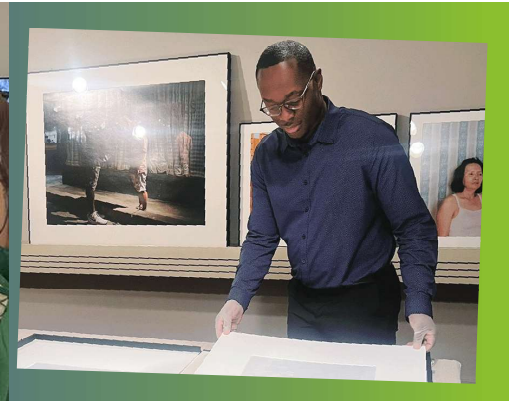

ELIGIBILITY

You must have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of \$6250 or less. This number is included in the Student Aid Report on your FAFSA form.
