We are seeking a multimedia designer to join our growing team. This designer position supports a range of projects which require the presentation of technical content and industry-specific topics relevant to our company and customers, including: spacecraft, ground and space communications and network concepts, antenna and hardware, complex technologies (example: optical communications, quantum communications), and science concepts (example: how a space-based telescope works). The core activities require collaboration with technical and program leads to define the messaging and objectives of the content, and to iterate on product development. Products vary by project and may include:

- **Imagery:** Collaborate with technical and program leads to understand the desired messaging and objectives for the project, which may range from presentation material (PowerPoint), to educational material (posters or pamphlets), and figures in technical documents (reports, proposals, etc.)
- **Animation:** Custom animation to explain systems, technical concepts, and analysis.
- **Audio:** Podcast development, in support of outreach or training materials development.
- **Text:** Development of draft text to accompany figures, graphics, and animations, etc.
- **Video:** Capture, edit, and produce videos (both from events recording and from animation products) for training courses and public outreach.

This position is also responsible for maintaining the company website, deploying updated multimedia content as applicable, and recommending design changes to keep the public-facing content fresh and relevant. Potential to expand into responsibility for social media content development and deployment.
