

Meeting minutes, ITSC Meeting Oct 22, 2021 , 3 pm

1. Computer Replacement Initiative (Tony Moriera)
There will be a Computer Replacement Initiative this year. It will be based on the base amount of \$49,000. A little less than previous years. This is because of the budget shortage.
2. Library Innovation Lab (Patrick Dawson)
Construction in the summer of 2022. Light duty lab. It will be a place where you don't need to be involved in the college to use it. It's a place where people will be able to prototype ideas that they want to bring further.
The sooner we can get this functioning, the better it's a massive pro for potential students.
3. ORCID Program (Caroline Sheffield)
Open Researcher and Contributor Identifier ORCID
With an ORCID ID, you get to tell what different names you are listed under when you publish your work. You decide who can see your ORCID registers. ORCID allows you to connect between other systems and saves time. Today we have 1486 ORCID UMBC profiles.
4. Proposal for DUO rollout (Mark Cather)
All staff except 700 have been migrated into Duo. In Early November, ask the last 700 to enroll. Mid-November, flip the switch and force them over. For students, it will be voluntarily for fall 2021. For winter and spring, it will be required for all incoming students to enroll in Duo. Academic year 22/23 migrated all students into Duo
5. Electronic Public Directory (Damian Doyle)
How can we have a secure Directory not available for everyone not affiliated with the University? Most schools have blocked looking up students if you are not affiliated.
Proposed changes are to remove unauthenticated access to look up students through the directory.umbc.edu website and remove unauthenticated access to query LDAP from off-campus. Still possible to lookup faculty and staff.
